

Major philanthropic investments have been made to:

- Establish the first in the nation Harold Alfond College Challenge program, which makes college scholarship grants of \$500 to every baby born in Maine;
- Build the Harold Alfond Center for Cancer Care, which consolidated MaineGeneral Hospital's cancer care programs in Central Maine into a single 59,000-square-foot facility, equipped with the latest technology, and designed to offer multi-specialty treatment planning and coordination;
- Construct the University of New England's Center for Health Sciences, which houses the state's only medical school;
- Create a Children's Garden at the Coastal Maine Botanical Gardens;
- Launch an endowment for the Alfond Youth Center, the nation's only combined Boys & Girls Club/YMCA; and,
- Construct athletic fields, complexes, and facilities for many colleges and universities in the State of Maine.
